LESSON 12: WEALTH IS A HOME (RELATIONSHIP) IN THE LORD

Read For This Week's Book Study

Proverbs 3: 5, Proverbs 3: 9-10, Ecclesiastes 5: 10, Matthew 28: 20, John 15: 4-5, 1 Timothy 6: 17-19

Memory Scripture: "And my Elohim will fill every machzor (shortage, want) of yours according to osher (riches) in Kavod Moshiach Yehoshua (Christ Jesus)." —Philippians 4: 19 (Hebrew Book)

Key Scripture: "Conversation without covetness and be content with such things as ye have, for he hath said, 'I will never leave thee, for forsake thee'." –Hebrews 13: 5 (KJV)

Word Study: The Hebrew word עוֹשֶׁי oshuer (awe-sure) means "wealth". However, the Hebrew word for tithe is מַשְּשֵׁר ma'aser (ma-ash-sure) and both operate differently. Tithing involves giving a portion of one's income or produce as instructed by Elohim or for charitable purposes. Segullah (s'gool'lah) which encompasses reveals how Elohim measures their wealth. Elohim measures it in us. The more people who choose to have emunah and accept Yeshua as their savior, the more who accept the offer of salvation and cleanse themselves through the blood of Yeshua, the wealthier Elohim becomes. The sons of the Lord is the oshuer; not the things they create that reflect creativity, but their sons who choose a relationship with them is what makes Elohim full of wealth, not riches, not gold, people and relationship.

Tehillim/Psalm 103: 1-2 says,

"Bless the LORD, O my soul and all that is within me, his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul

and forget not all his benefits." (KJV)

Tehillim/Psalm 112 1-3 says,

"Praise ye the LORD. Blessed the man feareth the LORD, delighteth greatly in his commandments.

His seed shall be mighty upon the Earth, the generation of the upright shall be blessed. Wealth and

riches in his house and his righteousness endureth forever." (KJV)

Yirmeyah/Jeremiah 29: 11 says,

"'For I know the thoughts I think toward you.' Saith the LORD. 'Thoughts of peace and not of

evil, to give you an expected end." (KJV)

I want to point out that this specifically is confirming that Elohim's plans are good and intended to

protect and nurture people. It emphasizes that Elohim's intentions are not to bring about evil or

destruction. This should not be confused with verses that show Elohim's righteous wrath and holy

anger towards bastard sons who serve and honor Lucifer. The wages of avon is death and all avon

will be punished at some point. It rains on the just and the unjust to avoid showing favoritism and

to keep the field fair for saved and unsaved. Even so, there is validation for Elohim's decision to

come and rain chaos over evil on Earth. It is warranted because of evil and because he allots us

time to repent. When we choose to repent not, they have the right to do what is necessary to purge

evil from their design and their kingdom on Earth. Remember, Lucifer is "renting" Earth and trying

to prove he is a better king and can replace Elohim altogether.

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Giánnis/John 10: 10 says,

"'The thief cometh not, but o steal and to kill and to destroy. I come that they might have life and that they might have more abundantly."

If Lucifer is such a good king, why did Yeshua have to come down here? Why did Yahweh, the Torah, the Brit Chadasha and even now in the modern age, have to occasionally rise up and defend what was his against Lucifer, the so called the king of this realm? Why Is Elohim constantly fighting him and defending their followers and their planet? Because that is their purpose as good deities and good rulers of their kingdom, despite that they must allow the law of free will to be active. They also have to flex and demonstrate their might and punish the world because evil's purpose, that is to say, Hell's entire purpose, is to rob, steal, kill and destroy everything in sight. Free will matters, free will is given to everyone and Elohim, who is the author of free will, also reserves the right to remind their creation that it's their world and we just live in it.

If we avon and do not repent, we suffer for it on this Earth and if we die in our avon, we go to jail for our crimes. If Lucifer commits evil and sows seeds of discord on Earth, Elohim can purge it off when they've had enough of it. This is not a contradiction to their holy, loving character that is so widely mentioned in the Book Of Tehillim (Psalms). Its's just spiritual politics and Elohim having to use their authority to make evil stop when it gets to be too much for their followers or in some cases, themselves. Even Elohim gets sick of Lucifer's war crimes and poor battle tactics that are clearly costing people their lives and butchering our daily understanding of who they are.

As you can see, Lucifer and his followers are nothing more than a bunch of deceptive, oppressive thieves and murderers. Let's break down the scriptures and allow me to explain something many people miss when they weight Elohim in their mind. When considering the goodness of the Lord and you come across a scripture that promises you a good time and benefits and you live the

opposite of that promise or know someone who's in a bad place and suffering, it's understandable if you think the Lord is a hypocrite. However, the Lord is not a liar.

Neither of them lied when they had these scriptures composed for us to read. So, what happened? Why are you and I seeing what does appear to be a contradiction to their own words? It's more simple than you might realize. As we have Earthly policies and politics, so does *Shamayim* (Heaven). In Enoch, he experienced a lot of things, one major theme being spiritual policies and politics. A much as Hashem wants us to receive these bountiful benefits and have protection 25/7, the law of free will won't allow it.

Picture the Lord creating a beautiful paradise and making this awesome nature home and domain, just for you to explore, love and enjoy forever. Picture the Lord granting you immortality and the only means to renew it is eating from a tree that produces a life source of fruit. Now, picture the three of them, gazing at their perfected creation and asking you to move in because by their free will, they wanted this and wanted you, beautiful you, whom they formed in their image to have it, free of charge.

Only to have another person come into your home, set up their stuff and rob you of your happiness, health and lifespan. This same person, breaks your home, puts you against your lover and doesn't apologize before being evicted from your home. A home that your lover decided to sell to the enemy when disobeying your Lord's orders and now, must bear the consequences of their actions with you, you who listened to your lover and also ate of a fruit you weren't supposed to touch. Now, you're sorry. Your lover is sorry and you have asked the Lord for forgiveness, but sadly, the enemy isn't sorry and goes out against your kids, grandkids, great-great grandkids and oh yeah—you're entire descendant chain to do the same tactic over and over.

Because, that's politics. That's free will, and the policy of free says everyone can have it, but what we do with it, is on us and no one else. People we were there and we're still there. We had perfection, had a good home and the promise of a great life, but our grandparents messed up and set the stage for us in this way. Yeah, they were sore and sorry, but avon means we must break the consequences of our actions and carry it. It became too hard to carry, so Christ had to come down and carry it for us and he did—straight to his death on a cross. Adom and Chavah's free will was

good, until they sinned (fell short). Yeshua's free will was lovely and yet, he used it to save us rather then yell and beat us or slander us for our mistakes and our ancestor's mistakes. Lucifer however, doesn't care, hasn't learned anything and refuses to say he's sorry or make up for his actions towards Elohim, much less us.

This is how the Lord can say they're good, have good intentions and plan and future for us in one breath, then tell us this life will be full of toil and troubles and sorrow in the next breath. It's not contradiction, it's free will being equally expressed by everyone in existence. For better or for worse, our free will and the policy Elohim created for it is good and stands, even now.

It's just a shame that some beings, celestial or terrestrial, would rather use their free will and the power of their hands and mouth, to hurt others, rob, steal and destroy. This is not the will of Elohim and this wasn't how free will was supposed to work and yet, if they take away Lucifer's free will, they must be fair and take everyone's free will away and that isn't a life, that is a cage. That is a life of forced worship, forced I love Lord, forced praise, forced relationship with our Creator, etc. If you love something, you don't put that loved one in a cage and manipulate their every move. As a deity, Elohim lets everyone roam freely and express themselves, even at the cost of having their perfect will and their benefits sabotaged by the enemy. Don't become their enemy, because should you have avon in your life, you are aligning yourself with Lucifer and Lucifer is Elohim's enemy and one day, Elohim will rise up and throw him off their planet for good into the Lake Of Fire and seal him away forever.

Never mistake someone going to Hell the will and sheer force of Elohim. Elohim hates having to turn people away. In their free will, they laid down their own body when Yeshua was here and died so we could have the opportunity to return home and exercise our free will properly, healthily and appropriately. Lucifer wants to keep playing the fool, robbing, stealing and destroying us with his free will. And has a right to do that, but it doesn't make him a good king and it certainly shouldn't convince you or I, that he has our best interest. If Lucifer, who selfishly declared himself a king, believes his so good at what he does, why is called The Father Of Lies, Lord Of Flies or Lord Of The Dead? Why did Yeshua stay in the Book Of Giánnis/John 8: 44, which says,

"You are of your father the devil and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him."

Yahweh, Ruwah and Yeshua truly mean what they say, but beware—so does Lucifer and his followers. Know the difference and don't mistake what you're feeling and seeing for the goodness and holy rainbow promises of the true king and the prince of truth who is the sole reason you have life and can utilize free will at your discretion.
